### **DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS**

The Truckee Fire Protection District is a bi-county District governed by a five-member Board of Directors, who are elected at-large by the voters within District boundaries to serve staggered four-year terms.

Prospective candidate(s) must be a registered voter and reside within District boundaries to be eligible to run for office.

Elections are held every two years, during even-year November General Elections.

Elections are conducted by Nevada County and Placer County. Prospective candidate(s) interested in running for office are required to file candidate nomination papers with their County of residence. Prospective candidate(s) may contact their respective County Elections Division.

The Act requires public disclosure of certain investments, interests and incomes that may pose potential conflicts of interest. Newly elected public officials are required to attend Ethics Training and Harassment Prevention Training within one year of taking office.
